Classic and luxurious, the **Deluxe Junior suites** are individually and tastefully furnished. From the balcony, guests have a stunning panoramic view over the surrounding Bernese Alps or Gstaad.

Dining

Enjoy international cuisine in the **“Le Grill” gourmet restaurant.** The top chefs prepare delicious dinners right in front of your eyes in the show kitchen. 

Palace Spa

Whatever guests desire from a spa complex, the Palace Spa will exceed expectations. Their exclusive wellness complex offers 8 treatment rooms, a private spa, Jacuzzi, saunas and steam baths, a unique Hammam experience, a relaxation area with fireplace, a spectacular view and much more over 19,375 ft². The mountain setting is reflected in the spa with its 196 ft long stone wall built with granite from the nearby Blausee region.

Gstaad Palace offers plenty of options to work out at the hotel. Guests can visit the fitness room equipped with high-quality Technogym equipment or book a private Pilates session. They can swim in the indoor pool, open every day from 7:30am to 9pm, or the Olympic-sized outdoor pool, open only in the Summer from 9:30am to 7pm. There are also 4 tennis courts and personal training.



Walig Hut

Experience an oasis of tranquility 5,905 ft above Gsteig. The Walig Hut offers a breathtaking view over Gstaad and the Saanenland region. The authentic Swiss alpine hut was built in 1786 and has only been slightly renovated since then. As a result, it has preserved its simplicity.

Gstaad Palace offers guests an exclusive lunch or dinner for 4 to 14 people at the Walig Hut. Guests can stay overnight, but a maximum of 2 adults and 2 children. A 3—course menu with starter, simple main course and dessert with swiss wine, mineral water and coffee is served for lunch and dinner.
